The 12th Edition of Miami Performance International Festival '23 (M/P '23), will be held in a hybrid format, combining in-person and online film screenings and events. The in-person components of the festival will take place in Miami Beach, FL and at Edge Zones Art Space, Miami, FL. The online components will be hosted through Edge Zones virtual YouTube and Facebook platforms, and archived in our Vimeo Channel with most screenings accessible globally. .

Starting on June 14<sup>th</sup>- 17, 2023 the festival will open with a one-day virtually streaming program consisting of performance videos and video works. It will culminate with two days of in-person live performances on June 16 and June 17th, 2023, curated with the participation of local Miami, national and international artists at the Miami Beach Library Stage, Miami Beach, FL on May 17th, and at Edge Zones Art Center in Miami on June 16th, 2023. This festival puts M/P'23 artists at all career stages in critical dialogue with one another and with M/P'23 audiences.
