Contamination, dirt and otherwise out of place

This edition of the Creative Enquiry Forum draws on Mary Douglas' concept of 'matter out of place' to interrogate how architectural practices conceptualise and deal with difference, purity and contamination.

Our practices often rely on notions of order to make sense of their doings in the world, passing aesthetic judgement when thinking of materials and the making and unmaking of form itself. Purity marshals materialities that make exploitation and colonisation invisible; Empire and capitalism recruits dirt and difference to justify their expansionist projects. To say someone and something is out of place invokes pasts and persistent presents of inequality and racism, and configures our ideas of the future, often exposing our utopias as betraying the politics of homogeneity.
